November 2nd, 2020

7:00 Meeting called to Order by Chairman Nate Chaffee.

The Board reviewed and accepted minutes from the October 26th meeting.

Recognition of Visitors:

John Revilla informed the Select Board of its requirements to hold and run any Public Information meetings for the Broadband Committee. Old Business:

Andrea Cheeney, one of the organizers thought that having it behind the Municipal Building was much safer because they did not have to worry about traffic and crossing roads. She hopes that they may be able to continue to hold Trunk or Treat in the same area next year.
3. Lou reported that the loan agreement from Mascoma Bank for the new Rescue Truck has been signed.
4. The Board reviewed an email from Doug Beach detailing what service projects that the Fall Mountain JROTC have the choice of doing at the Langdon Cemeteries for Veteran's Day preparations.
5. The Board reviewed and accepted the resignation of Jessica Jarvis as Town Clerk and Administrative Assistant.

New Business:

1. The Board reviewed an email from Scott Hunter requesting to move gravel from the Pleasant Valley farm in Langdon to their Pomeroy Farm in Walpole. The Board is forwarding this to the Planning Board.
2. The Board reviewed an email soliciting work on the Crane Brook Road bridge. It was discussed that the bridge has been fixed and the road deck will last for quite a few years more. It will also be 5 more years before we can get any funding for this.
3. Lou reported that the dehumidifier in the Heritage room was taken and put in the Town Hall to remove moisture. It was decided that they will get a replacement for the Heritage room.
4. The Board discussed the possibility of closing the Town Hall for the winter. They will have to ask the church if they are going to try to have their cookie swap this year. If they are not then they will close it up and turn off the water.
