November 8, 2021

Meeting called to order at 7:03 pm by Chair Devin Gallagher

The Minute of the Meeting of November 1st were accepted as read unanimously. (Nate/Lou 3-0)

Old Business:

1. Status of Broadband - We should have a report sometime this coming week as to how far they have gotten on putting out fiber – first report from Consolidated – coming along
2. Update on FEMA - Waiting
3. Interware program - Diane should be up and running the middle of this month. Diane and Tina will be trained the middle of the month.
4. New Copier and scanner and off-site storage – Linda will call them again on Wednesday
5. GOFERR/ARPA funds - The meetings started with CivicPlus this week on the new website- Also there is a new grant program through ARPA where the Town could get back \$50,000 on the Rescue Truck which the Fire Department will receive in December. The application was submitted. Linda Campbell requested a laptop computer to keep the Treasurer info. Lou will purchase one for her. The Treasurer, Town Clerk, Tax Collector and Administrative Assistant are going to look at the office space and rearrange it to suit them.
6. Lou got the new Town signs and Todd will install one of them and store the other.
7. Nate took the Registration for the Rescue Truck and he is going to the Keene DMV to see if he can get plates.
8. Jonathan had gotten info on the value of the 2011 Cruiser so the Selectmen could sell it. The Bluebook value is between \$19,000 and \$23,000. The Selectmen instructed the Administrative Assistant to compose a bid to be put out for selling it and bring it to their meeting on Monday.
9. A discussion ensued about adding a 2nd man to the Highway Department next year who would also do the Cemetery mowing's. Lou spoke to Todd about it and he is in favor. Lou also asked Kevin Beal if he would be interested if it became available next year and asked him what he would need to take the job. As Lou said at some point Todd would retire and it would be nice to have a replacement. However, the Selectmen are going to have to look into what it would cost the town and see if it feasible. This discussion was brought on by the fact that the Cemetery Budget will be increasing by around 100% and Highway Department safety concerns.
