UNAPPROVED SELECTBOARD MINUTES

March 6th, 2017

Selectboard Meeting reconvened at 7:01 by Chair Lou Beam.

- 1. Lou discussed with the Board that he had been trying to get in contact with Mike Fuerst, Town Attorney, concerning the non-public meeting the prior week but had not yet received any reply.
- 2. Lou also discussed that the insurance carrier for the Food Shelf had come in for an inspection that went well. The insurance agent requested exit signs that the Food Shelf will put up and Lou will start up and head a safety committee. The Food Shelf is applying for a \$15,000 grant to help with operating expenses.
- 3. The Board discussed the Highway Budget.

New Business:

- 1. The Board discussed Town Meeting. The Corrected warrant article will just need to be addressed by the Moderator at the time the article is presented and corrected sheets will be passed out. Also, Dennis had requested a sign be posted to warn residents of the step down leaving the building. The Board discussed who would speak to each article.
- 2. Lou brought up that the steeple on the Meetinghouse does need to be done. He thought that the work on it could be paid from the Buildings budget as not much has been earmarked for its use. The money spent by the Town on the steeple could also go toward the 50/50 for the grant to redo the other sides of the buildings clapboards.
- 3. The Board discussed that next year the only big projects scheduled are the other side of Hemlock Bridge and the finishing of a sand shed. It was also discussed that the State has a bill on the table to cut welfare spending; so the Town may have to pick up more.
- 4. The Board reviewed and signed an application for a Veteran's Credit.
- 5. The Board reviewed and signed two Intents to Cut.
- 6. The Board reviewed and signed a PO for the Road Agent.
- 7. The Board re-signed a Timber Cut Warrant.
- 8. The Board reviewed and signed payroll.
