- 4. The Board reviewed an email from Dennis McClary concerning the Steeple project on the Meetinghouse. Lou explained that LCHIP would not have credited the Town for money spent on the project prior to their approval of the grant. The steeple

project will be postponed until next spring and the remaining three sides of the building will be resided at the same time. Lou noted that the Town will save money not only through the grant but also with the renting of equipment.
